C. Quill Pen



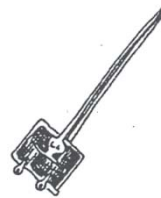
It looks like a dog brush, but it is used to prepare wool for the spinning wheel.

E. Bed Warmer



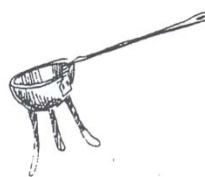
